The Business, Technical, Vocational Education and Training (Establishment of the Uganda Business and Technical Examinations Board (UBTEB) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

*(Under section 29 of the Business, Technical, Vocational Education
and Training Act, 2008)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 29 of the Business, Technical, Vocational Education and Training Act, 2008, this Instrument is made this 11th day of March 2016.

1. Title.

These Regulations may be cited as the Business, Technical, Vocational Education and Training (Establishment of the Uganda Business and Technical Examinations Board (UBTEB) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

2. Amendment of S.I. No. 9 of 2009.

The Business, Technical, Vocational Education and Training (Establishment of the Uganda Business and Technical Examinations Board (UBTEB), Regulations, 2009, are amended in regulation 12—

(a) by substituting for sub regulation (2) (b), the following—

“(b) Deputy Executive Secretary Examinations Management;”;

(b) by inserting immediately after sub regulation (2) (b), the following new paragraph—

“(ba) Deputy Executive Secretary Finance, Human Resources and Administration;”;

- (c) by inserting immediately after sub regulation (2), the following—

“(3) A person shall not be appointed Executive Secretary unless that person has at least—

- (a) an honours bachelor’s degree in education or in a relevant field examinable by the Board, from a recognized institution;
- (b) a Master’s degree in business, a technical field or other field examinable by the Board, from a recognized institution;
- (c) experience of a minimum of ten years, seven of which are at senior management level and three in managing examinations;
- (d) a minimum age limit of 40 years.”

- (d) by inserting immediately after sub regulation (3), the following—

“(3a) A person shall not be appointed Deputy Executive Secretary Examinations Management unless that person has at least—

- (a) an honours bachelor’s degree in education or in a relevant field examinable by the Board, from a recognized institution;
- (b) a Master’s degree in business, a technical field or other field examinable by the Board, from a recognized institution;
- (c) experience of a minimum of eight years, five of which are at senior management level and three in managing examinations;

- (d) a minimum age of 40 years.”
- (e) by substituting for sub regulation (4), the following—
- “(4) A person shall not be appointed Deputy Executive Secretary Finance, Human Resource and Administration unless that person has at least—
- (a) an honours bachelor’s degree in a field examinable by the Board from a recognized institution;
 - (b) a Master’s degree in finance, accounting or business administration;
 - (c) a certified membership of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Uganda (ICPAU);
 - (d) a minimum of eight years experience in management, finance, human resource, administration or procurement, at least five of which should have been at head of department level;
 - (e) a minimum age of 40 years.”
