**The Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations)
(Amendment) Regulations, 2014.**

(Under section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges Act, Cap 201)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the President by section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges Act, these Regulations are made this 14th day of April, 2014.

1. Title.

These Regulations may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) (Amendment) Regulations, 2014.

2. Amendment of Schedule to Statutory Instrument No. 201-1.

The Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) Regulations, are amended by inserting immediately after item 19 of the Schedule to the Regulations the following—

“20. The Nile Basin Initiative.

21. The Association for Strengthening Agricultural Research in Eastern and Central Africa.”

3. Validation of extension of privileges.

The extension of diplomatic privileges to the Nile Basin Initiative, its staff and officials by S.I. 64 of 2012 is validated and shall be deemed to have been lawfully extended with effect from the 25th day of October, 2012.
