**The Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations)
(Amendment) Regulations, 2015.**

(Under section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges Act, Cap 201)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the President by section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges Act, Cap. 201 as transferred to the Minister responsible for Foreign Affairs by the President under paragraph 2 of the Transfer of Powers and Duties Order, Statutory Instrument No. 54 of 2014, these Regulations are made this 8th day of January, 2015.

1. Title.

These Regulations may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) (Amendment) Regulations, 2015.

2. Amendment of paragraph 2 of Statutory Instrument No. 201-1.

The Diplomatic Privileges (Extension to Prescribed Organisations) Regulations 201-1 are amended by inserting immediately after paragraph 2 (ce), the following—

- “(cf) the Aga Khan Foundation (Uganda);
- (cg) the Aga Khan Education Service, Uganda;
- (ch) the Aga Khan Health Service;
- (ci) the Aga Khan Trust for Culture;
- (cj) Aga Khan University (Uganda)”.
