The External Trade (Importation Licence)(No. 3) Order, 2004.

(Under section 8 of the External Trade Act, Cap. 88).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for trade, by section 8 of the External Trade Act, this Order is made this 9th day of July, 2004.

1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the External Trade (Importation Licence)(No. 3) Order, 2004.

2. Grant of exclusive licence.

(1) The person listed in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order is granted an exclusive licence to import used tyres of different sizes in the quantity listed in column 2 of the Schedule.

(2) The exclusive licence referred to in sub-paragraph (1) shall be valid for two months only from its commencement and shall then expire.

(3) If the licence expires before a person has imported the number of used tyres authorised by the licence, that person shall forfeit the balance of the tyres not imported.
