**The External Trade (Prohibition of Importation of Certain Batteries) Order,
2004.**

(Made under section 7 of the External Trade Act, Cap. 103).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister, by section 7 of the External Trade Act, this Order is made this 2nd day of September, 2003.

1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the External Trade (Prohibition of Importation of Certain Batteries) Order, 2004.

2. Prohibition of Importation of Batteries

No person shall import batteries of a type or category listed in the Schedule to this Order, three months after the coming into force of this Order.

3. Offences

A person who imports a product specified in the Schedule to this Order after the date specified in section 2 commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to the penalties prescribed under sections 11 and 12 of the External Trade Act.
