**The Local Governments Emoluments and Allowances (Amendment of First Schedule to Local Governments Act) Regulations, 2004.**

*(Under section 175 of the Local Governments Act Cap 243)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for local government by section 175 of the Local Governments Act, these Regulations are made this 12th day of August, 2004.

**1. Title**

These regulations may be cited as the Local Governments Emoluments and Allowances (Amendment of First Schedule to Local Governments Act) Regulations, 2004.

**2. Replace-ment of Regulation 1 of the First Schedule to Cap. 243**

For regulation 1 of the First Schedule to the Local Governments Act, there is substituted the following—

1. Payments to certain Chairpersons, Vice Chair-persons, Speakers and Secretaries

(1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), the chairpersons of local governments, the vice chairpersons, speakers and secretaries of district councils and vice chairpersons of municipal councils shall be paid such emoluments and allowances as the councils shall determine subject to the Local Government Financial and Accounting Regulations.

(2) The Minister shall fix the minimum emoluments and allowances to be paid under sub-regulation (1) in consultation with the Minister responsible for finance and the Minister responsible for public service".

**3. Amendment of the First Schedule to Cap. 243.**

The Local Governments Emoluments and Allowances Regulations appearing in the First Schedule to the Local Governments Act are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 2 the following—

2A “Salaries of District and Sub-county Chairpersons

The salaries of district chairpersons, chairpersons of municipal councils and chairpersons of town councils and sub-county councils shall be paid from local revenue generated from the district, municipality, town or sub county as the case may be.

2B Monetisation of benefits

The benefits of district chairpersons and members of executive committees and speakers of district councils shall cease to be paid in kind but shall be consolidated into a salary the minimum of which shall be determined by the Minister under subregulation (2) of regulation 1”.

**4. Replace-ment of Regulation 6 of the First Schedule to Cap. 243**

For regulation 6 of the First Schedule to the Local Governments Act, there is substituted the following—

6. “Categories of allowances

The allowances payable to local government councillors and members of the district service commission, all local government committees or boards and other allowances of lower councils shall be determined by the minister in consultation with the Minister responsible for finance and the Minister responsible for public service and shall be classified in the following categories—

- (a) night allowance in Uganda;
- (b) night allowance outside Uganda;
- (c) safari day allowance within Uganda;
- (d) transport allowance; and
- (e) sitting allowances”.
