PROCLAMATION

BY EDWARD K. SSEKANDI

**SPEAKER OF THE PARLIAMENT
OF THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA**

WHEREAS Parliament was prorogued on Thursday 21 May 2009, thus marking the end of the Third Session of the Eighth Parliament of Uganda:

AND WHEREAS Clause (2) of Article 95 of the Constitution empowers the Speaker to appoint the date of commencement of a Session of Parliament:

And whereas Clause (1) of Article 101 of the Constitution requires the President to deliver to Parliament an address on the State of the Nation at the beginning of each Session:

NOW THEREFORE

1. In exercise of the powers conferred on the Speaker by clause (2) of Article 95 of the Constitution, it is hereby proclaimed that the Fourth Session of the Eighth Parliament of Uganda do commence on the 4th day of June, 2009 within the precincts of Parliament;

2. Notice is hereby given that the President, under Cluse (1) of Article 101 of the Constitution delivers to Parliment an address on the State of the Nation.
