**The Penal Code (Declaration of Uganda Wildlife Authority Uniform) Order,  
2004.**

*(Made under section 170 of the Penal Code Act, Cap 120).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Attorney General by section 170 of the Penal Code Act, this Order is made this 9th day of August, 2004.

**1. Title**

This Order may be cited as the Penal Code (Declaration of Uganda Wildlife Authority Uniform) Order, 2004.

**2. Declaration of uniform.**

The uniform described in paragraph 3 of this Order is declared as uniform for the Uganda Wildlife Authority (UWA) to be used exclusively by staff of UWA.

**3. Specific-ations of uniform**

(1) The uniform shall have the following features—

- (a) plain green colour with matching belt and boots;
- (b) distinctive UWA logo appearing on the top right hand upper arm of the shirt and on the cap; the logo is specified in the Schedule to this Order.

(2) The uniform shall comprise of a shirt, trouser, belt, boots, socks, sweater, jacket, hat or cap, suit, poncho, skirt, blouse and overall.

**4.** Any person who, without the authority of UWA, uses or wears a uniform, described in paragraph 3 of this Order commits an offence specified in section 170(2) of the Penal Code.
