**The Penal Code (Declaration of Uganda Wildlife Authority
Uniform) (Amendment) Order, 2015.**

(Under section 170(1) of the Penal Code Act, Cap. 120)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Attorney, General by section 170(1) of the Penal Code Act, this Order is made this 07th day of April, 2015.

1. Title.

This Order may be cited as the Penal Code (Declaration of Uganda Wildlife Authority Uniform) (Amendment) Order, 2015.

2. Amendment of Statutory Instrument No. 56 of 2004.

The Penal Code (Declaration of Uganda Wildlife Authority Uniform) Order, 2004 in this Order referred to as the principal Order is amended by substituting for paragraph 3 the following—

“3. Specifications of uniform

(1) The uniform shall have the following features—

- (a) plain green colour or camouflage pattern of green, cream and brown with matching belt and boots; and
- (b) the distinctive UWA logo specified in the Schedule to this Order, appearing on the top right upper arm of the shirt and on the cap.

(2) The uniform shall comprise of a shirt or blouse, trouser, belt, boots, socks, sweater, jacket, hat or cap, suit, poncho, skirt, and overall.”

3. Replacement of Schedule to the principal Order.

For the Schedule to the principal Order there is substituted the following—

paragraph 3(1) (c)

UWA logo

The UWA logo shall have the following features—

Two elephants in a movement motion facing the opposite direction of each other, with each elephant’s trunk turned upwards, carrying a leafy branch that encircles an inner green circle bearing the words “Uganda Wildlife Authority”, with a kob trophy embedded within a yellow circle which is in the center of the green circle; inscribed below the two elephants is the acronym “UWA”, beneath which is inscribed the UWA slogan “Conserving for Generations”.”
