**The Petroleum (Marking and Quality Control) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2016.**

*(Under section 6(2) (a) and section 44 of the Petroleum Supply Act, 2003,
Act No. 13 of 2003)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for petroleum supply by sections 6 and 44 of the Petroleum Supply Act, 2003, these Regulations are made this 28th day of October, 2016.

1. Title.

These Regulations may be cited as the Petroleum (Marking and Quality Control) (Amendment) Regulations, 2016.

2. Commencement.

These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 2016.

3. Amendment of SI. No. 56 of 2009.

The Petroleum (Marking and Quality Control) Regulations, 2009 are amended by substituting for regulation 11 the following—

“11. Fees.

The fees to be paid by importers for the testing and examination of petroleum products under these Regulations shall be thirteen Uganda shillings and twenty cents for every litre.”
