**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)
(Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order, 2014.**

(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361 this Order is made this 25th day of November, 2014.

1. Title.

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order, 2014.

2. Temporary maximum speed limit.

A temporary maximum speed limit is prescribed up to a limit of 180km per hour for a driver of a motor vehicle, who compete in the Oilibya Mt. Elgon Rally from 28th - 30th November, 2014 in the district of Mbale, Palisa, Kumi and Bkedeia District.

3. Exemption.

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the Oilibya Mt. Elgon Rally to be held from 28th to 30th November 2014, in Mbale, Palisa, Kumi and Bukedia districts, organised by the Federation of Motor Sport Africa Club (MOSAC), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, S.I. No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of the rally.
