**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)  
(Exemption) (No. 6) Order, 2015.**

*(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister of Works and Transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 29th day of September, 2015.

**1. Title.**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Exemption) (No. 6) Order, 2015.

**2. Exemption.**

A person who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the UMOPOC Independence rally to be held from the 23rd to the 25th October, 2015, in Mukono, Wakiso, Luwero and Buikwe Districts, organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of Uganda (FMU), in conjunction with United Motor Sport Club (UMOSPOC), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, Cap. 361 and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, 2004, S.I. No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of that rally.

**3. Temporary maximum speed limit.**

A person, who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the UMOPOC Independence rally mentioned in paragraph 2 above shall not exceed maximum speed limit of 180 kilometers per hour, for the duration of the rally.
