**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)  
(Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order, 2014.**

*(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361 this Order is made this 4th day of August, 2014.

**1. Title.**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order, 2014.

**2. Temporary maximum speed limit.**

A temporary maximum speed limit is prescribed up to a limit of 180km per hour for drivers of motor vehicles, who compete in the Pearl of Africa Uganda rally, 2014 to be held on 15th-17th August, 2014.

**3. Exemption.**

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the Pearl of Africa Uganda rally on 15th -17th August 2014, in Kampala, Wakiso, Luwero, Mukono and Nakaseke districts, organised by the Federation of Motor Clubs of Uganda (FMU), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, S.I. No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of the rally.
