**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)  
(Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) Order, 2016**

*(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act 1998, Cap. 361)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister of works and transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act 1998, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 21st day of January, 2016.

**1. Title.**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) Order, 2016.

**2. Temporary maximum speed limit.**

A temporary maximum speed limit of up to 180km per hour is prescribed for drivers of motor vehicles, who compete in the FMU sprint to be held on 04th - 06th March, 2016.

**3. Exemption.**

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and who competes in the FMU sprint to be held on 04th - 06th March, 2016, in Mukono, Buikwe and Luwero Districts, organized by the Federation of Motor Sport Clubs of Uganda (FMU), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998 and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, 2004, S.I. No. 33 for the duration of that rally.
