**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)
(Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order, 2015.**

(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister of Works and Transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 26th day of March, 2015.

1. Title.

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order, 2015.

2. Temporary maximum speed limit.

A temporary maximum speed limit is prescribed up to a limit of 180km per hour for drivers of motor vehicles, who compete in the Eastern Motor Club Rally to be held on the 3rd to 5th April, 2015.

3. Exemption.

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and who competes in the Eastern Motor Club Rally to be held on the 3rd to 5th April, 2015, in Mayuge, Jinja and Iganga Districts, organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of Uganda (FMU) in conjunction with Eastern Motor Club (EMC), is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998 and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, 2004, S.I. No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of that rally.
