**The Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle)  
(Exemption) (No. 3) Order, 2003.**

*(Under section 136 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998,  
Act No. 15 of 1998).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for works, housing and communications by section 136 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, this Order is made this 11th day of April, 2003.

**1. Citation**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Exemption) (No. 3) Order, 2003.

**2. Exemption**

A person who drives a motor vehicle and who competes in the three days rally competition organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Club of Uganda (FMU) and United Motor Sports Club (UMOSOC), commencing on 9th May and ending on 11th May, 2003 is exempted from the provisions of subsection (1) and (2) of section 121 of the Act for the duration of that rally.
