**The Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle)  
(Exemption) (No. 6) Order, 2003.**

*(Under section 136 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998,  
Act No. 15 of 1998).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for works, housing and communications by section 136 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, this Order is made this 26th day of September, 2003.

**1. Citation**

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Exemption) (No. 6) Order, 2003.

**2. Exemption**

A person who drives a motor vehicle and who competes in the Castrol-Mogas Independence rally competition organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Club of Uganda (FMU) and Uganda Motor Club (UMC), commencing on 24th October and ending on the 26th October, 2003 is exempted from the provisions of section 121 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, for the duration of that rally.
