The Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (Exemption) (No. 5) Order, 2013.

(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for works and transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, 1998, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 2nd day of December, 2013.

1. Title.


This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limit) (Exemption) (No. 5) Order, 2013.

2. Exemption.

A person who drives a motor vehicle or motor cycle and competes in the OILLIBYA MT. ELGON rally, organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of Uganda (FMU), in conjunction with Motorsport Africa Club (MOSAC) to be held 6th to 8th December, 2013 in the districts of Mbale, Manafwa and Sironko is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act and Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, S.I. No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of the rally.

3. Maximum speed limit.

A person, who drives a motor vehicle or a motor cycle or competes in the rally mentioned in paragraph 2, shall not exceed a maximum speed of 180 kilometers per hour, for the duration of the rally.
