**The Uganda Communications (Transfer of Assets to Uganda Communications Employees Pension Scheme) (Amendment) Instrument,**

2012.

(Under section 87(5) of the Uganda Communications Act, Cap. 106)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for communications by section 87(5) of the Uganda Communications Act, this Instrument is made this 27th day of March, 2012.

Title.

This Instrument may be cited as the Uganda Communications (Transfer of Assets to Uganda Communications Employees Pension Scheme) (Amendment) Instrument, 2012.

Amendment of S.I. No.42 of 2000.

The Uganda Communications (Transfer of Assets to Uganda Communications Employees Pension Scheme) Instrument, 2000 is amended in the Schedule—

in item 6 of residential properties with land titles, by substituting for “881” the figure “884”;

in item 4 of central, under the list of non-core assets and item 5 of central under the residential properties with land titles, by substituting for “street”, the word “avenue”;

in item 5 of western, under the list of non-core assets by substituting for “Plots 14-16”, the words “Plot 4”;

under western in the list of non-core assets, by inserting immediately after item 15, the following—

“16. Plot 15 Rwenzori Road Fort Portal”;

under northern in the list of non-core assets, by inserting immediately after item 5, the following—

“6. Plot 34 Independence Road Moroto 7. Plot 111 Pakwach Road      Pakwach”;

in item 4 of western under the list of residential properties with land titles, by substituting for “Layali Road Plot 14-16” the words “Tayari Road Plot 4”;

in item 5 of eastern under the list of properties without land titles, by substituting for “Nile Road Kapchorwa” the words “Plot 36 Tensing Road Tororo”;

in item 1 of northern under properties without land titles, by substituting for “Barinagweno Road Gulu” the words “Bwanagweno Road Kitgum”.
