The Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Amudat Community Wildlife Area) Instrument, 2003.

(Under sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996, Statute No. 14 of 1996).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for wildlife by sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996; and after consultation with the local government council of Moroto District; and with the approval of Parliament signified by its resolution passed on 27th May, 2002, this Instrument is made this 3rd day of April, 2003.

1. Citation

This Instrument may be cited as the Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Amudat Community Wildlife Area) Instrument, 2003.

2. Declaration of Amudat Community Wildlife Area as wildlife conservation area

The area of land specified in the Schedule to this Instrument is declared a wildlife conservation area to be known as Amudat Community Wildlife Area.

3. Area to be a community wildlife area and a wildlife management area

The area declared under paragraph 2 shall be a community wildlife area and a wildlife management area for the purposes of section 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996.

SCHEDULE

Boundaries of Amudat Community Wildlife Area

All of the following parishes: Loroo, Achoricor, Amudat, Katabok-1, Loburin, Katabok-2, Karita, Losidok and Moruita; excluding those parts of the above parties that are gazetted as Forest Reserve or Wildlife Reserve.

This boundary is more particularly shown on Boundary Plan UG/WILDLIFE/AMUDAT/01 deposited at the Survey Records Office in the Department Responsible for Surveys and Mapping.
