**The Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Rwenshama Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.**

*(Under sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996, Statute No. 14 of 1996).*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for wildlife by sections 18 and 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996; and after consultation with the local government council of Rukungiri District; and with the approval of Parliament signified by its resolution passed on 27th May 2002, this Instrument is made this 3rd day of April, 2003.

**1. Citation**

This Instrument may be cited as the Uganda Wildlife (Declaration of Wildlife Conservation Area) (Rwenshama Wildlife Sanctuary) Instrument, 2003.

**2. Declaration of Rwenshama Wildlife Sanctuary as wildlife conservation area**

The area of land specified in the Schedule to this Instrument is declared a wildlife conservation area to be known as Rwenshama Wildlife Sanctuary.

**3. Area to be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area**

The area declared under paragraph 2 shall be a wildlife sanctuary and a wildlife management area for the purposes of section 19 of the Uganda Wildlife Statute, 1996.

## SCHEDULE

**Boundaries of Rwenshama Wildlife Sanctuary**

Commencing at pillar RWE1 on the shore of Lake Edward, thence in a south-easterly direction on bearing  $163.5^{\circ}$  for a distance of 241.5 metres approximately to pillar RWE2; thence on a bearing of  $170.3^{\circ}$  for a distance of 218.3 metres approximately to pillar RWE3; thence on a bearing of  $163.9^{\circ}$  for a distance of 156.9 metres approximately to pillar RWE4; thence on a bearing of  $152.9^{\circ}$  for a distance of 258.7 metres approximately to pillar RWE5; thence on a bearing of  $155.1^{\circ}$  for a distance of 158.6 metres approximately to pillar RWE6; thence on a bearing of  $154.8^{\circ}$  for a distance of 209.9 metres approximately to pillar RWE7; thence on a bearing of  $251.5^{\circ}$  for a distance of 116.7 metres approximately to pillar RWE8; thence on a bearing  $244.4^{\circ}$  for a distance of 167.8 metres approximately to pillar RWE9; thence on a bearing of  $244.5^{\circ}$  for a distance of 130.5 metres approximately to pillar RWE10; thence on a bearing  $253.4^{\circ}$  for a distance of 92.6 metres approximately to pillar RWE11, thence on a bearing  $199.7^{\circ}$  for a

distance of 155.5 metres approximately to pillar RWE12; thence on a bearing  $284.16^\circ$  for a distance of 312.9 metres approximately to pillar RWE13; thence on a bearing  $311.6^\circ$  for a distance of 448.6 metres approximately to pillar RWE14; thence on a bearing  $35.2^\circ$  for a distance of 253.6 metres approximately to pillar RWE15; thence on a bearing  $49.7^\circ$  for a distance of 229.3 metres approximately to pillar RWE16; thence on a bearing  $356.6^\circ$  for a distance of 501.2 metres approximately to pillar RWE17 on the shores of Lake Edward; thence north-eastwards along the shores of Lake Edward to the point of commencement.

This boundary is more particularly shown on Boundary Plan UG/WILDLIFE/QENP/01 deposited at the Survey Records Office in the Department Responsible for Surveys and Mapping.
